Baron Vincenzo Lucchese Salati, is a professor of architecture at the University of Venice. A visit to the Leventis Municipal Museum in the early 1990s and his love for Cyprus and its history, was enough to urge him to begin a series of donations related to

the history of Cyprus, such as maps and etchings. He made his first donation in 1996 during a visit to the Leventis Museum by a Cypriot architecture student at the University of Venice, who delivered an etching with Queen Ekaterini Kornaro along with a message from her professor his intention to enrich the Museum's collection. Since then the Baron has donated over 30 items.
